FAQs

How do I know if I'm eligible for the support? Most businesses across Suffolk with 50-250 employees are eligible for the programme.

Will it take up a lot of my time? You will receive up to 4 days of support from the Suffolk Carbon Leaders team, both on site and off site. During the time we are at your site carrying out assessments we will need some assistance from you and other relevant staff, but will minimise disruption to your working day as much as possible.

Do I need to pay for anything? Support from the Suffolk Carbon Leaders team is free of charge. If our recommended solutions require investment we can provide access to funding and finance that can minimise costs and improve payback times.

Do I get any recognition for taking part? All participants have the opportunity to be assessed (or reaccredited) to the Suffolk Carbon Charter as part of this support.
