Over the past 4 years we have helped some of the most vulnerable members of the community, including many referred to us by social services and other local organisations like the Food Bank and charities helping those struggling with debt and with mental health problems. BUT we also help busy people and those that don't know how to do something or have the energy to do. In fact we help anyone that needs help – or more correctly we help each other.

St Neots TimeBank is a local, community-based organisation dedicated to bringing together local residents, creating a community network which is there to support community members in times of need. The organisation works by matching up those with the time, skills and energy to help others with those who need help. Those carrying out tasks can then 'bank' the hours they have given and request help in return from other members as and when they might need it.

TimeBanking helps people get their small repairs and jobs done, lives sorted and up to date and it can even help to get a job by adding it to a **CV**, plus we have been recognised by the **DWP** so a reference can help there too.


