Venue Information

Please note that all aisles and exits must be kept clear at all times. Standing is not allowed in the Main Auditorium during the performance. Latecomers will not be admitted until a suitable break in the performance. With certain productions we may not be able to show you to your booked seats until the interval. Drinking glasses/bottles and china are not allowed in the main Auditorium. The taking of photographs or recording any part of the programme is strictly prohibited. Please remember to switch off your mobile phone. The management reserves the right to refuse admission. The Playhouse is fully equipped with an infrared loop system. Please let us know your requirements when booking your tickets. Under 13's will not be admitted without an adult.
