Course Information:

Unit 1: Fire Safety Awareness

The importance of fire safety in the workplace is underpinned by health and safety legislation that places a duty on employers to establish policies and procedures and ensure their employees receive appropriate training.

This course is designed for all employees as an introduction to fire awareness and is an excellent ingredient in the induction programme of new employees. It deals with how fires can occur and what to do in the event of a fire.

The qualification also provides a foundation for those employees who want to develop their basic fire safety awareness. Successful candidates will be awarded a national level 1 qualification.

Duration:

A minimum of 4 contact hours in the classroom.

Certification:

The qualification does not have an expiry date but refresher training and keeping up to date with changes to policies, procedures and new legislation through ongoing CPD is vital.
