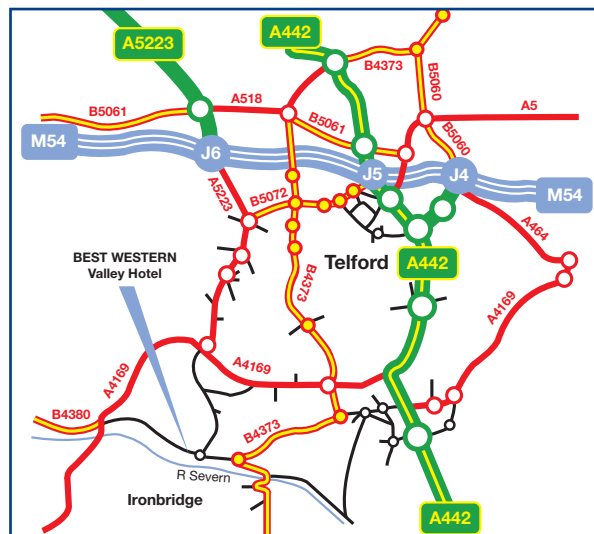

Take the 2nd exit signposted Coalbrookdale, and go down a steep hill and through traffic lights until you come to a mini roundabout. Turn right and the hotel is 200 metres on the left hand side.
