- Tips on photographing the cake and 'the cutting of the cake'

- Capturing the emotions and expressions of the speeches
- The challenges of photographing the first dance and how to overcome them
- Taking advantages of mirrors and reflections and what to look out for
- The power of window light
- The importance of having a good post production workflow in place to save you time and how to avoid dreadful mistakes
