Accidental Injury Cover

The cover is for treatment by our practice. However, when immediate treatment is needed, and your pet are away from home (anywhere in the UK), then cover is extended to include the nearest available vet. Terms and Conditions apply – further details of cover are available from the practice.

Extended Payment Scheme

For any treatment over £250, pet owners will have the facility to spread the payment over a number of months. Please note no discount is available if the Extended Payment Scheme is utilised. A deposit will be required. Use of the Extended Payment Scheme is at the discretion of the Veterinary Surgeon and subject to Terms and Conditions.
