THE TOWN POLICE CLAUSES ACT 1847

SUMMER RACE MEETING - EPSOM DOWNS

Epsom and Ewell Borough Council being of the opinion that the streets described in the First Schedule hereto may be obstructed by reason of a public rejoicing on the date specified in the Second Schedule hereto, in pursuance of their powers under Section 21 of the Town Police Clauses Act 1847 hereby make the following Order:

- The route to be observed by all vehicular and equestrian traffic between the points specified in the First Schedule on the date specified in the Second Schedule shall be that prescribed in the First Schedule hereto.
- In this Order the word 'street' has the same meaning as in the Town Police Clauses Act 1847.

FIRST SCHEDULE

On Friday 6th June 2014 and Saturday 7th June 2014

1. CLOSED STREETS

On Friday 6th June 2014 until Saturday 7th June 2014 from such times as may become necessary until normal traffic operation can be resumed, except with the permission of a police constable, or a traffic warden, the following parts of streets are to be closed to vehicular traffic:

Ashley Road Between Langley Vale Road and Downs Road

Ebbisham Lane Between Hurst Road and Walton Road

Tattenham Corner Road Between its 2 junctions with Tattenham Crescent.

(Racecourse crosses the road)

Walton Road South of the southern arm of the racecourse

2. PROHIBITED ENTRY

(a) During the period shown in paragraph 1 until normal traffic operation can be resumed, except with the permission of a police constable in uniform, or a traffic warden, vehicular traffic is not permitted to enter:

Morning

Grandstand Road

from roundabout outside Grandstand

Afternoon

Grandstand Road Old London Road from Buckles gap roundabout from Buckles gap roundabout

- (b) From such times as may become necessary until normal traffic operation can be resumed, except with the permission of a police constable, or a traffic warden, the following restrictions will be applied:
 - (i) Prohibit any vehicle from turning left from (A24) High Street, Epsom into (C195) Waterloo Road;
 - (ii) Prohibit any vehicle travelling in a north bound direction, apart from buses and coaches, from entering or proceeding along that length of (C195) Waterloo Road, between its junctions with (A24) High Street, Epsom and (C195) Station Approach;

3. ONE WAY STREETS

During the period shown in paragraph 1 until normal traffic operation can be resumed, the following streets and parts of streets are to be operated as one way streets in the direction shown:

Morning

Grandstand Road

from Buckles Gap Roundabout to a point 90m east

of roundabout outside Grandstand

Afternoon

Grandstand Road

from roundabout outside Grandstand to Buckles

Gap Roundabout

Old London Road

from Tattenham Corner Road to Buckles Gap

Roundabout

4. WAITING VEHICLES

During the period shown in paragraph 1 until normal traffic operation can be resumed, except with the permission of a police constable in uniform, or a traffic warden, vehicles are not permitted to wait in the following streets or parts of streets:

Rosebery Road between the junctions of Langley Vale Road and Harding

Road

Strand Close

Woodcote Side

5. STANDING VEHICLES

From 4pm on Saturday 7th June 2014, buses and coaches waiting to pick up passengers may stand in Ashley Road, north west of the junction with Langley Vale Road.

Buses and coaches waiting to pick up passengers shall stand in Station Approach as directed.

7. TAXI CABS

Friday 6th June 2014 and Saturday 7th June 2014 – A cab rank will be available as follows:

- (a) Downs Road From a point 20m north-west of the roundabout outside Grandstand for a distance of 30m in a north-westerly direction
- (b) Downs Road From a point 60m north-west of the Equestrian Crossing (near the junction with Derby Arms Road) in a north-westerly direction for a distance of 150m. This area will act as a feeder for the rank specified in 6(a).

All drivers to remain with their cabs while they are on the rank.

Drivers of the cabs are not permitted to loiter on the approach roads on the Downs.
