Manchester Conference – November 2014

Timebanking UK held their Annual General Meeting and Conference in Manchester.

The 2 day event brought together Timebanks from all over the UK, America and Europe.

Keynote presentations gave an insight into how well established the principles of Timebanking are worldwide. "How to" Workshop and advice sessions over the 2 days covered such diverse



topics as developing existing Timebanks, funding and sustainability, engaging and encouraging the next generation of volunteers, co-production activity. Networking opportunities brought together TimeBankers to share experiences, knowledge producing many links and plans for future projects and collaboration.

The overall impression was one of enthusiasm, innovation and diversity along with the absolute dedication and support for Timebanking in all its spheres of activity. It was reassuring that the St Neots TimeBank is also attuned to this and has evolved instinctively along similar lines to other initiatives.

The Timebank Principle is firmly established in the UK and internationally. Timebanks in the UK and around the world engage in similar activities and projects, from shopping trips to construction projects. In England community 'grow your own' exchanges are popular, in America one Timebank has well and truly gone large to supply enough produce to satisfy the demands of their members. The group persuaded local farmers to plough an extra furrow around their field edge. Timebankers supplied the seeds and enjoyed the results of the harvest. The Farmer benefited from volunteer work such as small scale maintenance and clean-up of Barns and Yard. Post-harvest field gleaning of various fields by Timebankers resulted in a supply of produce which was sold in the local market raising funds to sustain the Timebank movement. Obviously every little helps but scale of effort can dictate the returns. As we have so often said "Timebank activity is limited only by the imagination.

TBUK Conference was an almost overwhelmingly – inspirational, educational and relevant in all aspects. Congratulations and big thanks to the TBUK Team for a splendid and rewarding 2 days and the work they do throughout the year supporting Timebanks.
