Burn camps have been running in the UK for nearly 20 years and are there to support young burns survivors, their families and carers.



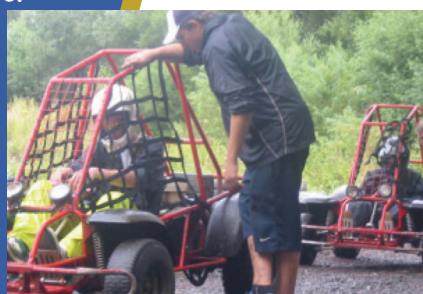
All Proceeds Going Towards Camps For Young Burns Survivors
