Loneliness and how TimeBank can help

A survey done by 'Campaign to end loneliness' showed that 1 in 5 elderly people are lonely and have no one to call on. A previous survey showed that loneliness is as harmful as smoking 15 cigarettes a day. I realized too that it's not only elderly people that become lonely or depressed and just knowing that there is someone to call can make a world of difference.

I agreed to set up a TimeBank to help people that needed help for any reason. However I have realized just how much it can help elderly people that are lonely, even depressed. This has been proved many times over the three and half years that we've been helping people.

However it has also revealed that reaching these people is difficult as they are too proud to ask, or unaware of how we can help. They also feel that they have nothing to offer back. I surprise people when I show them a list of things that can be offered and they realise they have many of those skills. Plus of course we don't insist on hours being in credit - opposite to a bank.



I feel alone, and I feel like I will be that way for a very **I o n g** time.

But you won't be as a Timebanker

If you feel isolated or get depressed then why not contact us – no pressure to join just someone to talk to. Maybe you know someone who would benefit from a call from us. Help us to help those that need a caring person to call.

In the words of the TimeBanking founder Edgar Cahn

"We have what we need if we use what we have."

- TimeBanking was set up based on the idea on social prescribing, that people need community and social opportunities as much as medicine
- TimeBanking raises self-confidence by encouraging people to use and recognise their assets instead of being defined by need or poor heath
- This increased self-confidence leads to people making more positive life choices -i.e. diet and exercise and remembering to take their medication
- The belief is that this social prescribing frees up time in GP appointments to deal with medical issues rather than just 'chat' with lonely people
