To see and hear him live with his impressive band from main stages to iconic venues like London's 100 Club and Lichfield Guildhall, Schofield's ability to connect with audiences immediately and profoundly is unforgettable. His authenticity, mastery of guitar, emotive vocals, and improvisational brilliance are brought to life with innovative original compositions, as beautifully captured on the recent live album 'Ten From The Road'.

Founded in 2011 by like-minded jazz students at Birmingham Conservatoire and led by saxophonist Callum Roxburgh who cut his teeth playing in the big band tradition.

An exciting concert in this fine venue featuring four of Britain's finest jazz musicians. Leader Steve



Waterman is a professor of Jazz Trumpet at Trinity College, London. Joining him are Gareth Williams (piano), Alec Dankworth (bass) and Dave Barry (drums). The quartet will play a mixture of tunes from composers such as Benny Golson, Wayne shorter and Chick Corea plus some of Steve's own compositions. Wonderful, stirring, swinging, mind-blowing, tasty, unforgettable music.

Get ready for a great night of Blues performed by two of the Midlands finest.

Steve Ajao Blues Giants

This band play simply good-time, classic, sparkling blues with humour and finesse. They are Steve Ajao (guitars/vocals), Mick Hatton (bass) and Pete 'Washboard' Hammond. Close your eyes for one moment and you will think you are listening to a band from the Mississippi Delta and the next second Jimi



Hendrix. They are a must-see group, extolling the blues, who have been entertaining Midlands fans for many years. Watch out for Steve's amazing voice and colourful shirts.

Rebecca Downes Band

If you enjoyed Steve Ajao then get prepared for Rebeca Downes' explosive soulful blues.

She is blowing the cobwebs away with her soul-tinged blues helped along by her amazing band made up of herself (vocals/songwriter), Steve Birkett (guitar/ songwriter), Dan Clark (bass), Rick Benton (keyboards/ Hammond organ), Rik Sandford (lead guitar) and Lloyd Daker drums.

They perform original compositions punctuated by some classic covers. Besides the blues, expect to hear elements of funk, rock and jazz delivered with warmth, humour and passion. A live act which is blowing the British Blues Scene completely upside down.

The quintet play a mixture of tunes inspired by some of Nick's favourite trumpeters plus some of Nick's own compositions. Expect to hear tunes written or recorded by Freddie Hubbard, Tom Harrell and Chet Baker to name but a few.


COOL RATS - HOT LICKS!


They are leader, John Etheridge
