Rourne Hall Museum Kids Club bringing history alive



Learn to shape flints like the ancient Stone Age craftsmen and discover the lost art of making stone tools. As part of a small group under the tuition of master flint knapper, James Dilley, enjoy the opportunity to make your own authentic stone age tool to take home. Learn some of the ancient survival skills needed to live in a hostile environment, where woolly mammoth and sabre toothed tigers roamed freely.

There will be an opportunity to buy some replica tools so bring some pocket money if you wish.

Children must wear trousers and closed shoes for protection during this activity, other safety equipment will be provided.

Cost per child £12, payable in advance. This includes the cost of materials to make the tool which will be yours to keep. For prepayment please make cheques payable to E&EBC and either post or hand deliver them to Bourne Hall Museum.

Places are limited to 12 children per session so pre-booking is essential.

A training excavation for budding archaeologists will be held during August. This will be a real dig in the grounds of Bourne Hall; where in the past artefacts from the Stone Age to the Victorian period have been uncovered. Children will learn basic archaeological methods and skills on a genuine excavation.

The dig will take place in Bourne Hall Park on the following dates:

Tuesday 16, Wednesday 17, Thursday 18, Tuesday 23, Wednesday 24, and Thursday 25 August.



Two sessions per day: 10am to 12.30pm and 1 pm to 3.30pm.

Children must wear closed shoes and appropriate clothes (sunhats or raincoats) and bring their own drink.

Meet at the main entrance to Bourne Hall.

£5 per session (payment in advance); each session is limited to 5 children so pre-booking is essential.
