PRICES FOR CLASSES AND PRIVATE LESSONS FROM 1ST MAY 2017

Due to increasing costs, we have reluctantly decided to increase the prices for some classes & private lessons.

Prices for a single class will remain at £5 for children and £7 for adults, however for adults staying for a double class on Monday, Wednesday or Sunday, the cost will now be £9 per person.

For those adults attending the Thursday Latin Rhythms class and staying for practice, the cost will remain at ± 10 for the evening.

The cost of private lessons will rise to £28 for children (under 16) and £32 for adults (over 16).
