Surrey Police are offering free Domestic Abuse support cards to Surrey-based businesses



Free domestic abuse support

Surrey Police is building awareness of domestic abuse and how devastating its impact is on victims. This extraordinarily complex issue is more than skin deep, as abusers seek to isolate, manipulate and ultimately control victims, effectively keeping them hostage.

Many victims of domestic abuse see the workplace as a safe haven that helps them keep a sense of normality. However victims can be targeted at their place of work and it is well known that some may hide the issues from their colleagues and employers because they are ashamed or are worried about being seen as a problem.

To try and help as many people as possible, Surrey Police has produced a card that looks like a coffee shop loyalty card that discreetly features the number of Surrey's domestic abuse helpline.

We have also developed a door hanger, similar to hotel 'do not disturb' signs that can be displayed in washrooms and / or changing areas.
