

## **FLOWCHART**

Preparation and drafting of divorce petition.

Seek agreement/consent from Respondent where appropriate.

File Petition at Court with fee, original marriage certificate and certificate with regards to reconciliation

Court will issue petition and serve it on the Respondent. In some cases other arrangements for service will be required.

Respondent to complete and return Acknowledgement of Service

Petitioner to make an application for Decree Nisi and file a statement in support.

Court to consider application and, if content, grant a Certificate of Entitlement to a Decree with date for Decree Nisi

Court pronounces Decree Nisi

Petitioner applies for Decree Absolute no less than 6 weeks and 1 day after Decree Nisi has been pronounced.

Respondent applies for Decree Absolute no less than 3 months after the date the Petitioner could first make the application.

Decree Absolute pronounced and the marriage is dissolved.
