

#### **Polish Night Menu**

#### Starter - soups

'Barscz chrzanowy' – Red borsch soup. The classic Polish beetroot soup with potatoes. (option to make vegetarian). **or** 

'Zurek' – sour rye soup served with a hardboiled egg and a variety of polish smoked meat.

#### Main courses

'Bigos' – a very traditional Polish stew using various cuts of meat, smoked sausage and sauerkraut. Served with mash potato. **or** 

'Pierogi' – Polish dumplings stuffed with curd cheese, onion and potato. Topped with fried onion and a dollop of sour cream. (vegetarian option) **or** 'Schabowy' – Breaded pork chop served with mash potato and browned cabbage (fried cabbage with dill in a creamy sauce).

#### **Dessert:**

'Wuzetka' - Polish chocolate cream pie made of two layers of chocolate sponge layered with Polish jam and whipped cream, topped with chocolate icing and dots of whipped cream. or

'Sernik' (cheesecake) - a national dish of Poland. Served with fruit compote.
