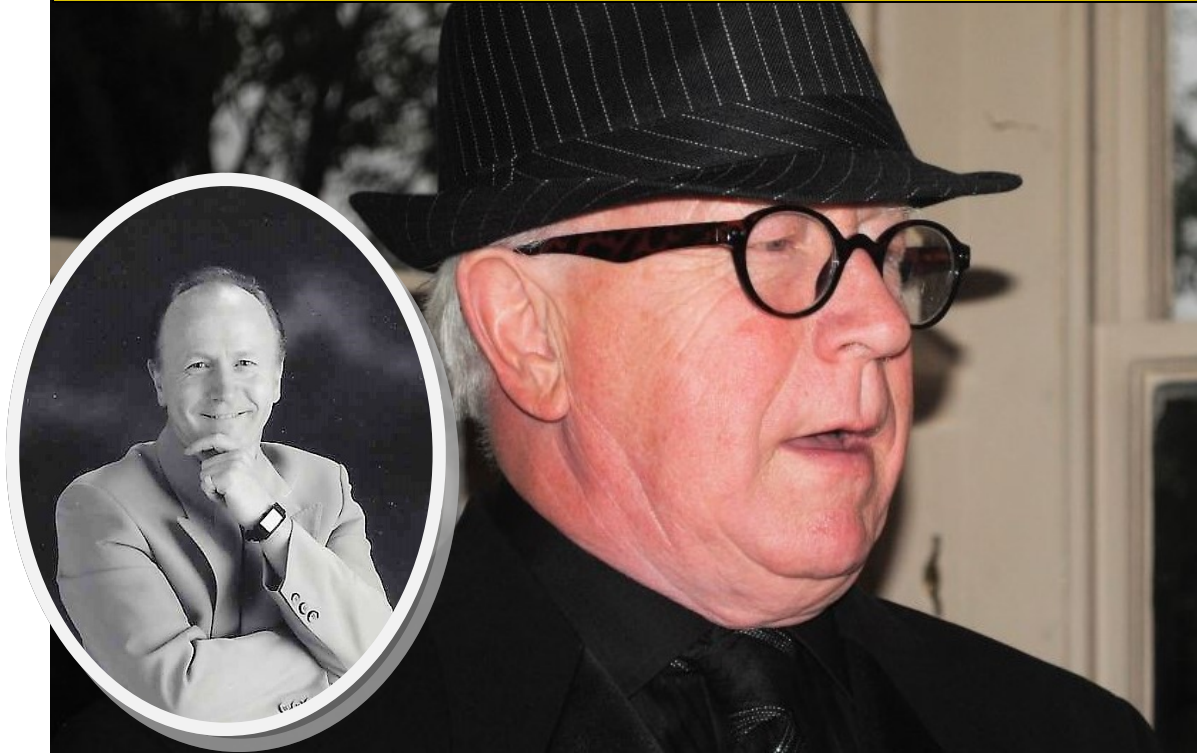

Many will know Mike from his days at local radio station 'BRMB' and he has been involved in broadcasting since he was 13 years old. He has worked for the BBC and commercial radio and won two of the Radio Industries 'Oscars' including Radio Station of the Year.

Not only has he interviewed a range of celebrities from Sir Tom Jones to Prince Charles, but Mike has also been involved in the management of over 50 major events across the UK since 1990 involving over one million attendees. Artists include The Spice Girls, UB40, Sugababes, Girls Aloud, Lionel Ritchie, Madness and The Script.

Most recently he has been involved with the development of the UK's number one pop event The Fusion Festival stars include Jessie J, The Wanted, The Vamps, Union J and Ed Sheeran. He was also TV's Jeremy Kyle's first producer.

Nowadays, Mike is Chairman of the oldest broadcast organisation in the world -The Television and Radio Industry Club of the Midlands - founded 1934 (well, second behind London).

Mike does a number of presentations, many tailored for Universities and colleges, as well as of general interest. His 'Radio Daze' talk focuses on radio through the years and some of Mike's shocking and hopefully amusing incidents with the rich, famous and the great British public!
