# The Pajama Game

a musical comedy

6-10 November 2018 at The Bridewell Theatre, London

As the nation marks **Equal Pay Day** once again in November this year, leading London musical society **Geoids** will perform "**The Pajama Game**" — a musical comedy with a story about **workers' rights** at its heart.

This production will transport the audience to the Sleep-Tite factory in the American Midwest, where union-crossed lovers "Babe" and superintendent "Sid" battle it out for a pay rise of 7 and a half cents for the workers. In today's money, that's approximately over £1,000 a year on a salary of £15k - a cause worth fighting for! What follows is a rollercoaster ride of exuberant dance and drama, featuring songs such as Fosse classic "Steam Heat" and infectiously happy "Once a Year Day".

Co-directors Grace Iglesias Fernandez and Emma Coffey make their **directorial debut** with Geoids, having earned their stripes performing in previous Geoids productions *Sweet Charity*, *My Fair Lady* and *On the Twentieth Century*. Musical Director Paul Cozens returns to the fold following *Top Hat* last year and choreographer Cara Turtington brings a wealth of experience from her work with other London societies.

All the Pajama Game leading roles are being played by **new Geoids members**, so this is an exciting opportunity to see fresh talent on the stage at The Bridewell Theatre, London. Katherine "Babe" Williams is being played by Lois Howarth, Sid Sorokin by Will de Renzy-Martin, Hines by Nathan Pollpeter and Gladys by Gayle Bryans.

With an impeccable pedigree, The Pajama Game was a hit in the golden age of the musical. The show's collaborators are now renowned for their award-winning Broadway shows: George Abbott (A Funny Thing Happened on the Way to the Forum), Jerome Robbins (West Side Story), Hal Prince (Fiddler on the Roof) and Bob Fosse (Cabaret). It is a testament to their work that this show is as relevant today as when it first came to the stage in the 1950s.

Join Geoids this November for an uplifting story of love, laughter and playing fair.

## About the show The Pajama Game

- Credits Book by George Abbott and Richard Bissell. Music and Lyrics by Richard Adler and Jerry Ross. Based on the novel "71/2 cents" by Richard Bissell
- Original Broadway production (1954) The show was directed by George Abbott and Jerome Robbins and choreographed by Bob Fosse. John Raitt and Janis Paige starred as Sid Sorokin and Catherine 'Babe' Williams.
- Tony Awards (1955) It won Tony awards for Best Musical, Best Actress and Best Choreography.
- West End transfer (1955) the show opened at the Coliseum in London and ran for a year and a half.
- Film (1957) Hollywood sweetheart Doris Day starred alongside original leads Carol Haney, Eddie Foy Jr and John Raitt, who reprised their Broadway roles.
- Revivals A 2006 production starred Kelli O'Hara and Harry Connick Jr as Babe and Sid. Richard Eyre's Chichester production in 2013 earned a five-star reviews and transferred for a limited West End run at the Shaftesbury theatre in 2014.
- **Geoids** Previous amateur productions have been performed by Geoids in 1991 and 2005.
