Thursday 18th July, 10am-3pm- £35

Using real prehistoric tools found in Surrey for inspiration, learn to cross stitch a flint design in a hoop to take home. No previous experience necessary, all equipment included and refreshments provided. Lunch not included.



Archaeological Photography

The swirling patterns found in Iron Age art form the basis of this beading workshop where you will make your own Torc inspired bracelet to take home. All equipment included and refreshments provided, no experience necessary. Lunch not included.



Crochet a Torc

Thursday 29th August 10am-3:30pm - £40

An experienced crochet teacher will help you crochet your own life size Iron Age torc to take home. A basic level of crochet is needed (chain, slipstitch and double crochet). Please bring your own 3.5mm crochet hooks, but wool and pattern will be provided. Refreshments will be provided but please bring your own lunch.
