Will you have some **#Purple4Polio** fun on **Friday 22nd October**, and help make history, by supporting Rotary's efforts to free the world's children of the life-threatening and disabling poliovirus? Sadly, the whole world now understands that a virus is just a plane ride away. We have safe and effective vaccines for polio with Rotary and our partners delivering around 2 billion doses annually to over 400 million children in more than 40 countries.

Purple is the colour of the dye placed on a child's little finger to signify they have received their lifesaving polio vaccine drops when millions of children in a country or region are immunised in a day!

The polio expertise, personnel, and infrastructure are continuing to play a significant role in the Covid-19 response in many countries with less sophisticated healthcare infrastructures and provision. The cold chains established for the safe delivery, storage, and administration of the polio vaccines have provided invaluable insights for the Covid-19 vaccine rollout. This is just a small example of the many legacies of the polio programme which is not just wiping out polio.

Rotarians across the globe are helping with Covid-19 vaccinations and are playing an important part in helping their communities through the challenges and in Covid-19 recovery as we start to learn how to live with it. Other Rotary projects continue to adapt to the ever-changing circumstances whilst ensuring we continue our fund-raising efforts for our top priority humanitarian initiative – wiping polio off the face of the earth. This has never been more important than it is right now.

Two weeks ago, for the very first time, there were no recorded cases of wild polio, vaccine-derived polio or environmental traces of polio found anywhere in the world. There is still a long way to go, and the Polio Eradication Strategy 2022-2026 sets out to urgently overcome the remaining hurdles to eradication, strengthen health systems in affected countries, and ensure all children everywhere are protected from this preventable disease. Whilst the whole programme costs around \$1 billion annually every one of us can make a difference because literally just 20 pence could provide the life-saving vaccine for a child.

This ties in with over 500,000 beautiful purple crocuses which bloom across our Bailiwick each Spring. Another 70,000 will be planted in the next few weeks. These crocuses are a joint initiative between Rotary in Guernsey, Floral Guernsey, supporters, and the sponsors of the corms, Appleby Guernsey LLP. The annual purple haze reminds us the poliovirus is still a threat to children everywhere until the world sees zero cases and zero positive samples in water and sewage globally for at least 3 years.

We have come so far since Rotary made the promise back in 1985 to rid the world of polio but there are enormous challenges still to overcome, will you help by having **#Purple4Polio** fun. Remember every 20 pence can really make a difference and for every £1 raised it is worth £3 thanks to the Bill & Melinda Gates Foundation supporting Rotary's efforts to End Polio Now and forever with a 2:1 match!
