











I Remember Walsall Illuminations marks the 70th anniversary of the first annual Walsall IIIIuminations, which ran for a week in September 1951 as part of the town's celebrations for the Festival of Britain. The exhibition features photographs and videos which show how the event changed over the 57 years it ran in Walsall Arboretum, from buving in old Blackpool Illuminations features to using new lighting technologies such as lasers. It also includes memories and images of some people who visited or worked at the Illuminations.
