# Princess Alice Hospice in our local community

Our care area is huge – families in our Compassionate Communities are supported by our In-Patient Unit, as well as the Hospice at Home service, which consists of a team of specialist palliative care community nurses and a multi-disciplinary team of doctors, therapists and social workers, who look after 1000 people at any one time within our care area of more than 600 square miles, as seen in the map below.

The Wellbeing Centre brings together a range of specialised outpatient services and activities for people in our communities. Our aim is to help give our patients the best possible quality of life by helping manage symptoms, building their confidence and helping them take back control of their lives. The Wellbeing Centre offers access to nursing, therapy, social and spiritual support from our team of staff and volunteers and enjoy activities such as art, crafts, exercise and relaxation.



## Festive fundraising

Fundraising is a really important part of Santa Fun Run. The money you raise really will make a difference:

To help you raise as much money as possible, we recommend starting your fundraising as early as possible. If you opted to donate rather than fundraise when you signed up, it doesn't mean you can't still fundraise if you spot an opportunity or if someone offers to sponsor you.

Why not check with your employer whether they offer a matched giving scheme, where the company or organisation you work for matches the amount of money its employees (you!) raise for charitable causes?

Let your manager know that matched giving boosts the morale of employee fundraisers, encourages team building – and that there are tax benefits for the company too.
