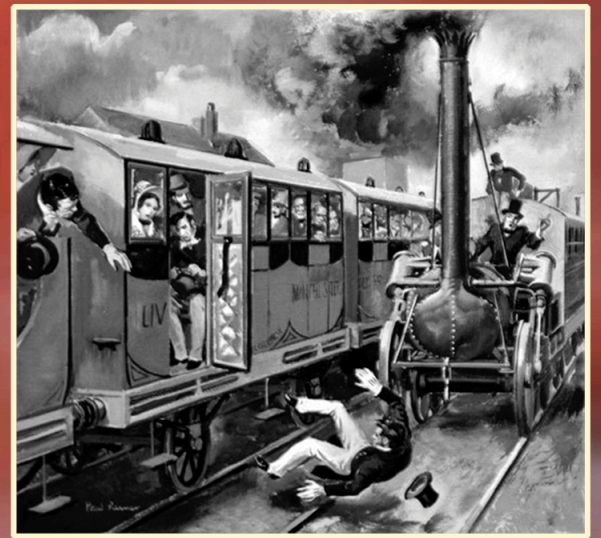


Red for Danger! in the Black Country

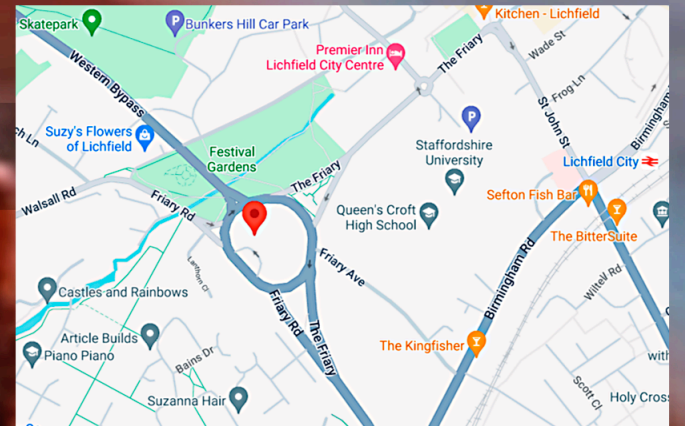
Finally, we'll look at consequences, including victims' memorials, legal claims and deodands, and the scapegoating of railway employees, deemed responsible for these dreadful disasters.
